Regulations regarding Shop with a Cop

1. Child must be present and accompanied by a parent or guardian on the shopping date. Purchases can not be made for children who are not present. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Each Child shall be a resident of Hendricks County. Enclose a utility bill to show proof of residency. You must be the Parent, or Legal Guardian of the child.
3. Merchandise **CAN NOT** be returned or exchanged. A list will be provided to the Meijer service desk for all items purchased by the Lodge on your shopping date.

Make sure all children try on clothes and shoes prior to purchasing the items. Anyone attempting to return merchandise will be reported to the Lodge and will be ineligible to participate in future assistance programs.

4. Each child will be allowed to spend a specific amount and will not be allowed to go over that amount.
5. Due to the number of children we take shopping, your shopping time with an Officer will be limited to 30 minutes. It's a good idea to have a specific list of items your child would like to have with you. You will be shopping at Meijer in Avon.
6. An approval letter will be mailed to the residence listed on this application. The letter must be presented on your shopping date.
